### **Note:**

A. This bibliography only scratches the surface and consists of works which are either well known or on which I have been able to lay hands in my own or the Mt. Angel library. It also ignores many of the older detailed monographs on separate parts of the Eucharist and its ceremonial, which can be very valuable. Whole books have been written on the history of the lavabo, the treatment of the remains after delivering the elements to the people and so forth. The mere size of the bibliography points out the danger of answering questions about proper procedure and custom in things Eucharistic with spurious exactness and unwarranted rapidity. You must examine your sources and leave questions open unless you are sure they are closed. This caution is at the heart of Episcopalian liturgical life.
